We are now offering self-service for faxes and copies for those who need it.

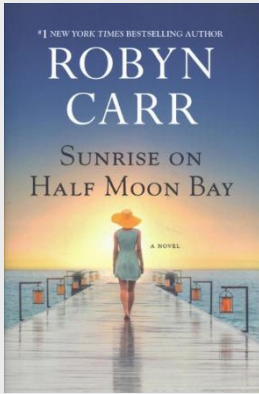

The outside book-drop, as well as inside BOOK/DVD drop baskets, are available.

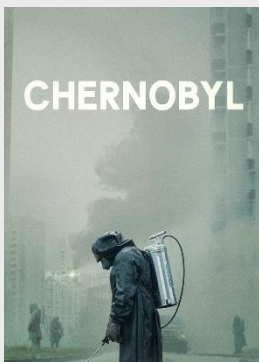
Do not place items on our circulation/front desk!

Thank you for your cooperation with these safety precautions, NPL staff.

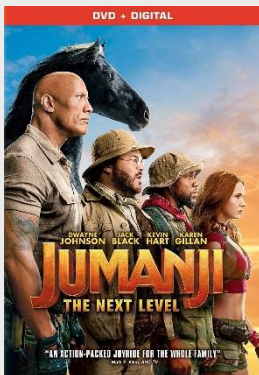
