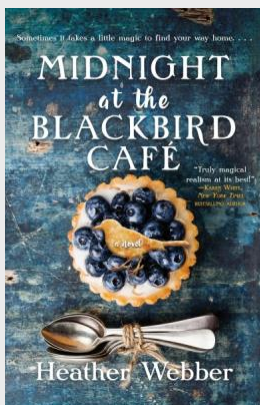
Story Hour

Passport

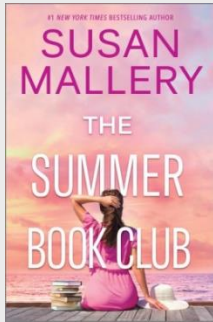


Adventures begin at your Clark County Libraries this summer! Grab a passport and visit the ten Clark County libraries between **May 1 - August 30, 2024.**

How to Participate:

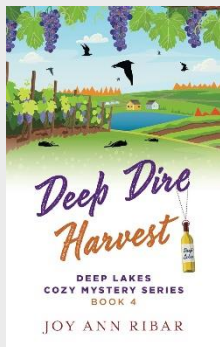
- **Pick up Your Passport:** From May 1st to August 31st, visit any Clark County public library to grab your exclusive passport.

- **Return by September 6th:** Return your completed passport to any Clark County public



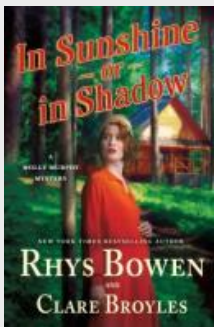

June 19, 2024, 1:00 pm Stuart Stotts storyteller/musician

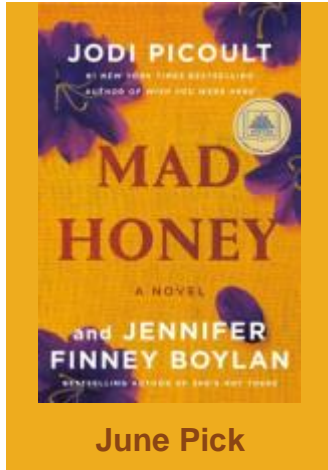

A to Z Reading Challenge

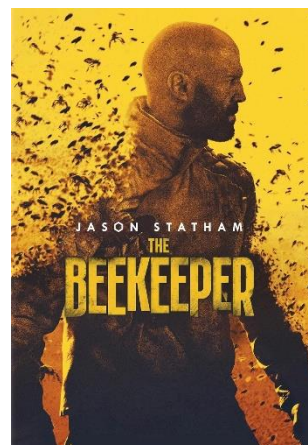

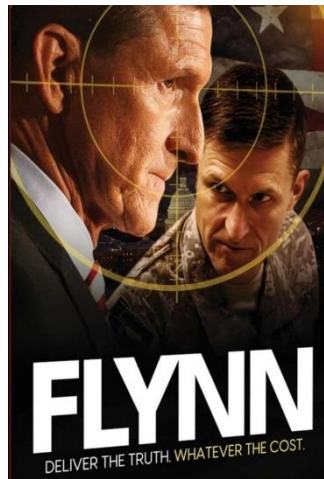
