



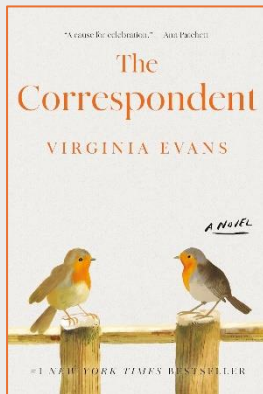

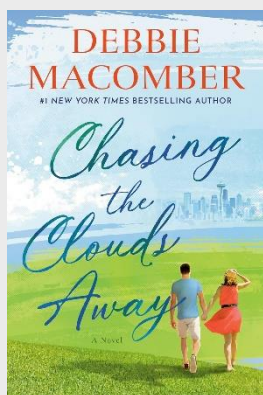

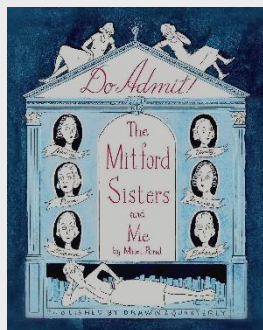
2026 Summer Reading Program



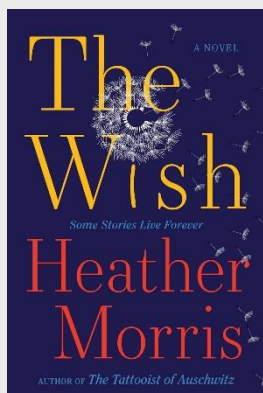
Get ready to dig into summer fun!
